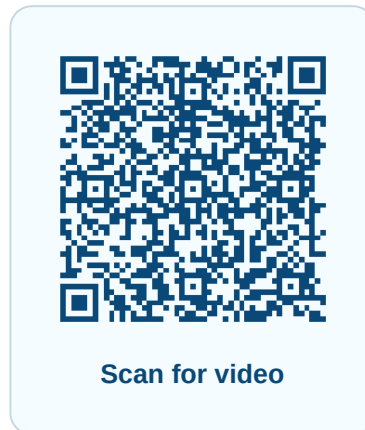


Create story tile

Step-by-step instructions for Create story tile in Express Me.

Step-by-step instructions

1

Enter edit mode

Enter edit mode and click **Add tile**.

2

Select the story tile

In the list of tile types, select **Story**, the tile with the small book icon.

3

Name the story

Type a name for the story (e.g., "Morning routine") and click **Create tile**.

4

Confirm the position

Drag the tile to the desired spot on the board and click **Confirm position**.

5

Open the story

Click the story tile to open it. The story is empty, so add the first image tile.

6

Add the first image

Click **Add tile** and choose **From the internet** to add the first step of the story (e.g., "waking up").

7

Confirm the first image

Select an image from the search results and click **Confirm position**.

8

Add more images

Repeat the previous steps for the rest of the story (e.g., "breakfast" and "cycling"): click **Add tile**, choose **From the internet**, select an image, and click **Confirm position**.

9

Review the story

Exit edit mode and open the story tile to view the complete sequence of images in order.

Hello everyone, my name is Rick from ExpressMe.

And I'm going to show you how to create a story tile in our app.

The idea is that it shows a kind of sequence or tells a story through a number of images in a certain order. I'm going to show you how we can do that.

We first go to edit mode and then we say, hey, we want to add a new tile. Then we see here a story with a small book. We click on that.

Then we can say what kind of story we want to create. Let's tell something about our morning routine. We do that by creating the tile and say okay, confirm position.

And then we can click on the tile. Then we see that the story is indeed still empty, so then we can start adding new images. Let's do that.

We start for example with waking up. And then we say okay, we want to create a tile. Then we can choose in what way we want to get the image. For convenience I'll now choose from the internet.

And then you see that a number of good images are loaded. And we choose one and then we can confirm the position.

Then, a story consists of multiple steps, so let's add two more tiles. We can for example say okay, we're going to have breakfast. And then we say again, choose image from the internet. And then we have this one. We say confirm position.

We can also add as first or as last closers. And then we choose cycling as the last step. Then we do again choose from the internet. Then we see here an image of the bike. Then we click on confirm position.

And if we now exit edit mode, what we then see, if we go back to the beginning, then all the way to the bottom. Then we see there our tile with the page, so filled with the images.

And then we see, this is the first step we made, waking up. Then we go to the next. Then we say okay, we're now having breakfast. And then we go cycling. And so we have been able to make a simple step plan in the app.
